(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

#### **Objectives:**

- The Parties intend by this MoU to ensure a mutually beneficial partnership.
- The Parties, based upon the principle of respect of each other's independence and of mutual benefit, will carry out the following activities collaboratively.

- a. Exchange of Academic, Research and Innovation Facilities
- b. To organize activities jointly regarding skill based education.
- c. Guidance & Support for Assessment and Accreditation Process

#### ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES:

- Maybe the Parties ought to jointly undertake academic, and research programmes and health awareness programs. They agree to the use of the experimental database generated by the joint project under this MoU. Output for collaborative research activities shall be published under joint authorship.
- Both parties shall constitute the committee to steer various activities of the MoU. The
  Principal of the College will be chairperson and senior staff of beneficiary department
  may be the member secretary of the Steering Committee. They shall meet at least twice
  in academic year.
- The Parties may formulate perspective plan and the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for its execution.
- In the implementation of the co-operative activities, each institution shall build on their respective strengths and shall clearly identify the roles in developing and implementing the projects.
- The first party will Provide Guidance on Assessment and Accreditation Process by arranging Seminars/Workshops/Visits. They will also guide on NAAC process, Documentation required, Role of IQAC in quality enhancement of the institution leading to completion of NAAC process.
- First Party will give valuable inputs to the second Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customization of the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario of their region meaningfully.
- Train the Faculties for imparting training, in new pedagogies, innovative assessment and research methodology and other relevant topics.
- Any amendment in the MoU draft shall be made after consultation and mutual written consent.
- With mutual consultation, the Parties can terminate the MoU.
- With mutual consultation, the validity of the MoU may be extended
- Share information with confidentiality as the main clause which does not harm the participating organizations.

- Create better working environments and better academic practices through collaborative projects.
- The issues with intellectual property right can be shared only with prior permission of the both parties
- Amendments, if any, in the MoU may be made in writing and signed by both Parties.

#### FINANCIAL:

- A Major objective is to establish common platform for Academic and Research Exchange and NAAC Guidance
- The Parties shall not demand any monetary charges from each other for the use of technology, teaching training, research and development.
